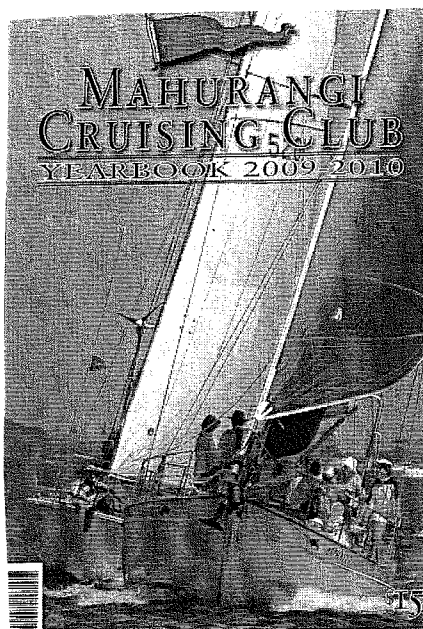

DIVISIONS FOR CLASSIC YACHTS AT MAHURANGI REGATTA

- 1 **Mahurangi Cup Division** – Wooden yachts designed before 1955 (Red Flag)
- 2 **Traditional Spirit Division** – Yachts of any age and construction not eligible for the Mahurangi Cup but designed on traditional lines (Long keel or traditional centreboard yachts (Blue Flag)
- 3 **Modern Classic Division** – Yachts of any construction not eligible for the previous 2 Divisions but designed more than 25 years ago (this includes Stewarts 34s and all other Fin keel boats designed between 1955-1985) (Green Flag)
- 4 **Te Haupa Trophy** – Traditional small wooden yachts under 20' of any age and design (Yellow Flag)
- 5 **Z Class/Frostbite** – Separate division races will be held for these classes and any other traditional class of 3 or more yachts (Yellow Flag)
