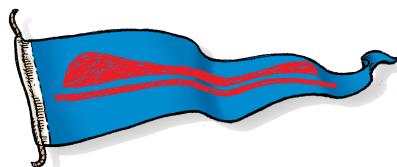

## YACHT DIVISIONS AT MAHURANGI REGATTA - 2018

### 1. Launch Parade

### 2. Te Haupa Trophy

Start time 12.40

MELLOW YELLOW



Definition: for traditional small boats under 20 feet length overall. This would include all traditional New Zealand Classes like Zeddies etc. but would not include modern classes like Lasers which we do not take entries for. It would include any other traditional style of boat such as sailing outriggers, proas, sailing dories and claw-footed bathtubs.

### 3. Frostbites, Mistrals, Zephyrs

Start time 12.50

### 4. Reactor & H28

Start time 13.00

ROYAL PURPLE



### 5. A-class

Start time 13.20

NAVAL ORANGE



### MAIN EVENT - start time 13.40

### 6. Mahurangi Cup

FIERY RED



Definition: wooden boats of pre-1955 design.  
No other type of construction but wood is acceptable.

### L-Class - Mulleties

NO FLAG

### Traditional Spirit Trophy

TRUE BLUE



Definition: boats of any age and type of construction which conform to a traditional spirit in their design, and are made of materials other than wood. It includes long keelers and traditional centreboard boats but not fin keelers.

Examples:

- A fibreglass mullet boat, a ferro cement H28, a steel long keeler would qualify
- A fibreglass Stewart34 will not qualify because it is a fin keeler; it will qualify for the Modern Classic Division. (see next entry).

### 7. Modern Classics

Start time 14.00

SEAWEED GREEN



Definition: Yachts of any construction designed before 1985 and are longer than six metres on deck and not eligible for the Mahurangi Cup Division or the Traditional Spirit Division.

#### Exceptions:

- Some Traditional Spirit boats such as H28 prefer to race in their own division and Association and therefore do not qualify for the Traditional Spirit Trophy;
- Some Modern Classics such as Reactor25 prefer to race in their own division and Association and therefore do not qualify for the Modern Classic trophy.

We do not take entries for any modern boats designed after 1985.

## Place Names

On NZ Maritime charts some place names do not appear. Sullivans Bay where beach and dingy race activities are held is marked as Otarawao Bay. Nor is Scotts Landing where the prize giving, marquee and band are held after the regatta. It is situated upriver just north of Casnell Island, recognisable by the old homestead (Scott Homestead) on the beach-front.

## Pontoon Wharf – Scotts Landing

Accessible to yachts only at high water. Almost dry at low tide. Please keep dinghies clear of piles.

### Parking

Parking at Scotts Landing is very limited and the dirt road to Scotts very narrow, we recommend you make use of the free shuttle bus on the Saturday evening. Parking will be signposted and the service is gold coin donation. Cars may be towed if they are parked and restricting traffic on the dirt road. Access must be kept clear for the shuttle bus and St John ambulance.

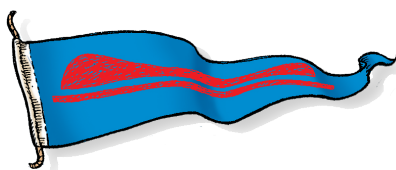
