
Te Muri Crossing — cocktails at Tu Ngutu Villa

he Mahurangi Coastal Trail is an Auckland Council, community, Mahurangi Coast Trail Trust, Ngāti Manuhiri, and New Zealand Walking Access Commission partnership project that will ultimately extend from Mangawhai to Waiwera. It will link 1000 contiguous coastal hectares of Auckland regional parkland, and form the first non-urban section northward on Te Araroa, the national walkway. This cocktail fundraiser with Distinguished Professor Sir Peter Gluckman, New Zealand's inaugural chief science adviser to a New Zealand prime minister, is to get the pivotal Te Muri Estuary boardwalk and footbridge shovel ready.

Hosted by Tu Ngutu Villa, which includes the Mahurangi Coast Trail in its ultimate Mahurangi Harbour and Hauraki Gulf panorama, attendees will forever be part of the creation of a greater Mahurangi Coast trail network rivalling the best in Aotearoa and globally. All this and a short talk by Sir Peter about the challenges New Zealanders face especially relating to biodiversity, environment, and health, and the role of trails!
