


100-metre wire-cable tethers attached to 25-metre chain terminating at midstream screw moorings, upstream and downstream








Proa pontoons at either bank advance and retreat with tide to minimise visual imapact and constriction of navigable waterway

Tether attaches ~33% back from bow through base of centreboard, for manoeuvrability and to keep cable below propellers and other appendages of passing craft.
