Mahurangi Coastal Trail—a community, council, and iwi partnership project—will ultimately connect from Waiwera to Waipū, link 1000 contiguous coastal hectares of Mahurangi regional parkland, and form the first, sublime, non-urban section of Te Araroa, the national walkway, north of the metropolis.

Distinguished Professor Sir Peter Gluckman—inaugural chief science adviser to a New Zealand prime minister—is guest of honour. Sir Peter will give a short talk about the challenges that New Zealanders face in democratically choosing an informed, sustainable future, **and** the role of the coastal trail.

Davis Coastal Consultants director, and trail trustee, Craig Davis will explain the choice of crossing route and describe the design of the boardwalk and bridge.
